Sections 1 - 3. Adopts recitals, findings of fact, and conclusions,
and states that the Council bases its findings and conclusions on
the entire record of Snohomish County Planning Commission and
the County Council.
Section 4. Amends regulations in SCC 30.28.010 pertaining to
detached ADUs in rural, resource, and other zones to: allow a
detached ADUs in rural, resource, in other proposed in serious containing a legally-estabilished singlefamily dwelling when the lot is at least 25,000 square feet; prohibit
detached ADUs in new buildings.
