AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN  
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT EF25-016G WITH PERTEET, INC.  
TO PROVIDE DESIGN SERVICES FOR DRAINAGE DESIGN SERVICES ON THE  
EVERGREEN STATE FAIRGROUNDS

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Evergreen State Fairgrounds Park's mission is to be an inclusive and accessible space for Snohomish County residents and visitors, fostering connections with diverse cultures, traditions and agricultural history; and

WHEREAS, the commingling of surface water has put stress on existing infrastructure resulting in flooding throughout the property and pollutant runoff from the site resulting in overflowing contaminants into wetland habitat; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department Ecology has granted funds from the Stormwater Strategic Initiative Lead fund to create a design to isolate the fresh water flowing from this wetland habitat across the Evergreen State Fairgrounds from surface water runoff and contamination; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources does not currently have the capacity to provide design services for this project, therefore, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources has determined a need for assistance from a consultant; and

WHEREAS, Perteet, Inc. responded to RFQ-25-0507LY and was selected through established Federal, State and County policies and practices; and

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council approves and authorizes the County Executive to sign Professional Services Agreement EF25-016G with Perteet, Inc. for \$732,140.16 and further authorizes the Director of Department of Conservation and Natural Resources or designee to approve amendments up to \$100,000, provided that sufficient appropriation authority exists, for a total amount not to exceed \$832,000.
