Subject: Snohomish Regional Drug Task Force – Interlocal Agreement

Scope: Motion 25-526 would approve the annual Interlocal Agreement for the Snohomish County Regional Drug Task Force for 2026-2027, to continue multi-jurisdictional efforts across Snohomish County to target drug trafficking and money laundering organizations. This contract is substantially similar to prior contracts except for the duration and automatic renewals.

All jurisdictions contribute to cover the cost of one commander and one analyst for the task force. Contributions are based on a per capita rate.

Exhibit D in the agreement shows the amount each jurisdiction party to this ILA will be paying for 2026 (updated annually based on population). Of the revenue/expenditure under this ILA (shown in the table above) the County's portion is \$102,049.

Authority Granted: Authorizes the Executive to execute the agreement.

Background: Since 1988 the United States Department of Justice has provided funds to the Washington State Department of Commerce under the Anti-Drug Abuse Act to provide grants to local governments for drug law enforcement. Snohomish County, and its cities, have been participating members since the inception of the Act, forming the [Snohomish County Regional Drug & Gang Task Force \(Task Force\)](#).

The Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional group created to coordinate law enforcement activities, resources, and functions with the intent of disrupting illegal drug trafficking systems and removing traffickers. Snohomish County serves as the fiduciary for the Task Force.
