HO-5 Report Overview

- The Housing Characteristics and Needs Report is a requirement of Countywide Planning Policy HO-5.
- It is prepared through SCT and provides data on housing characteristics and needs for jurisdictions to conduct major comprehensive plan updates.
- The HO-5 Report also includes the proposed Initial 2044 Housing Targets, which are consistent with the adopted 2044 Population Targets. The housing targets will come to council for adoption into the Countywide Planning Policies after the report is accepted by SCT.

2044 Housing Need Allocation

- The GMA housing goal, amended in 2021 by HB 1220, instructs local governments to "plan for and accommodate housing affordable to all economic segments of the population of the state."
- Commerce now provides countywide projections of housing needs for all economic segments and guidance for how those needs are to be allocated to local jurisdictions.
- Once adopted the County and cities will use these housing need allocation numbers in their analyses for comprehensive plan updates.
- Delays from Commerce in releasing these numbers have compressed timelines for the County's 2024 Update.
