SUBJECT: Disaster Declaration Number FEMA-4481-DR-WA

This memo is in reference to Disaster Declaration 4481-DR-WA COVID-19 Pandemic, Attachment 1 of the Special Terms & Conditions, Article II, A 1 Funding, DEPARTMENT Match, of the Grant Agreement which is subject to the following exceptions:

DEPARTMENT Match: The Washington State Legislature may authorize the DEPARTMENT to provide a match to the SUBRECIPIENT's non-federal share of eligible projects. Provision of a match by the DEPARTMENT, if authorized by the Washington State Legislature, shall not require amendment of this Agreement. If DEPARTMENT match funds are committed to the non-federal share by the DEPARTMENT pursuant to legislative authorization, the DEPARTMENT will formally notify the SUBRECIPIENT of the match in writing which will include information identifying any related reduction in the SUBRECIPIENT's percentage commitment.

During the 2023 Session of the State Legislature, the funding of the non-federal share of 4481-DR-WA costs was addressed. The State Legislature approved partial funding for the non-federal share which will be equally split for the eligible costs covered under the Project Worksheets for the 4481-WA-DR COVID-19 Pandemic event.

Public Assistance grant funding will be 90 percent federal funds, 5 percent state funds and 5 percent local funds.

We have updated your A-19A invoice vouchers to fund the correct share.
