## **Consideration:**

Authorizing the Snohomish County Executive to execute Amendment No. 1 with Arora Engineers, Inc. for integrated date management systems solutions at the Snohomish County Airport.

## **Background**

Snohomish County Airport has completed phase I & II of RFP 39-109SR contract with Arora Engineers, Inc. The result of the initial phases is the recommendation that the Airport implement a new Geographic Information System platform and create data standards to assist airport engineering in organization and accountability of County assets.

Proposed Amendment 1 of the contract with Arora Engineers, Inc. amends the scope of work to include Phase IIIA and IIIB Data Management System Implementation. Tasks include, but are not limited to: Develop airport data standards for geographic information systems (GIS) in collaboration with the County); Develop airport data standards for computer-aided design (CAD); Develop airport file structure and storage protocols in collaboration with the County; Establish Geospatial Data Governance Program report; Create a master computer-aided design (nCAD) files for PAE; Create FME workbenches (FMW) to convert CAD to GIS data; Create and populate a Master Geodatabase (MGDB) for PAE; Populate SharePoint/OpenText based on mutually agreed upon files and structure; Create GIS applications.

In addition, Amendment 1 extends to contract through December 21, 2023, and increases the not to exceed amount to \$462,000 to begin Phase III. The original contract was for \$45,000.

## **Current Proposal**

This motion authorizes the County Executive to execute Amendment No. 1 to Arora Engineers, Inc professional services contract not to exceed \$462,000.
