**Summary:** As of January 1, 2018, the Snohomish County Regional Public Safety Communications Interlocal Agreement (ILA) created Snohomish 911 (SNO911) and Snohomish County became a Principal Agency under the agreement. Pursuant to the terms of the ILA, changes to Governing Board composition and voting rights must be approved by the legislative authorities of the Principle Agencies. Ordinance 24-048 removes a non-voting position from the Governing Board and changes the calculation for establishing Police Agency caucus membership.
