PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-014

RELATING TO COUNTY BUDGET AND ASSOCIATED FISCAL PROCEDURES;
AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.16, 2.32, 3.36, 3.42, 4.35, 4.65, 4.70, 4.72, 4.73, 4.103,
AND 15.04 SCC

Summary: The ordinance is the first batch of necessary amendments to various sections of Snohomish County Code (SCC) to provide clarification related to annual/biennial budgets. With instituting a biennial budget for the 2025-2026 fiscal period, a Biennial Budget Workgroup was formed to address changes necessary in SCC to reflect biennial budgeting. This ordinance amends the following code sections:

- 2.16.020 Parks division duties
- 2.32.041 Revolving fund amount
- 3.36.010 Reimbursement for travel expenses
- 3.42.050 Administration
- 4.35.040 Use of fund
- 4.65.040 Operation of the fund
- 4.70.040 Payment of principal and interest
- 4.72.040 Operation of the fund
- 4.73.030 Fund operation
- 4.103.020 Sources of resources
- 15.04.080 Financing

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
