AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AMENDMENT #5 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EMERSON NETWORK POWER, LIEBERT SERVICES INC. TO PROVIDE SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE AND ON CALL EMERGENCY SERVICES TO THE COUNTY'S UNINTERRUPTIBLE POWER SYSTEMS (UPS)

WHEREAS, the County relies on dependable power supply and support systems to support its various infrastructures to provide essential civic and judicial services to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, properly maintained Uninterruptible Power Systems (UPS) are needed to support critical County operations; and

WHEREAS, fast and reliable on-call repair services are needed in case the UPS malfunctions; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Facilities & Fleet Management recommends the County approve a contract Amendment #5 with Vertiv Corporations ("contractor"), (f/k/a Vertiv Service, Inc. f/k/a Emerson Network Power, Liebert Services, Inc.) to provide scheduled maintenance and on call emergency services to the County's Uninterruptible Power Systems; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Emerson Network Power, Liebert Services Inc. dated December 16, 2011, entered as Single Source Contract SS-002-12, was in effect for three years from the date of execution by the County with options to extend for one or more additional years upon mutual agreement between the County and the contractor; and Amendment #1 extended the contract through May 31, 2018; and the contract Amendment #2 and #3 added the Denney Juvenile Justice Center and the Department of Emergency Management Buildings' Liebert UPS maintenance service; and Amendment #4 extended the contract for three years through November 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the contract Amendment #5, shall compensate the Contractor a sum not to exceed \$38,726 over the seven month term of the contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, the County Council on motion authorizes the County Executive to sign the agreement with Vertiv Corporation, to provide scheduled maintenance and on call emergency services to the County's Uninterruptible Power Systems.
