MOTION 22-437

CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF ROBERT OGAWA
TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, SCC 2.460.030 establishes the creation of the Snohomish County Human Rights Commission consisting of nine members nominated by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Commission shall serve in an advisory capacity to the County Executive, County Council, and other county officers and agencies in matters concerning human rights; and

WHEREAS, of the nine members on the Commission, one shall represent the County Executive, one shall represent the law enforcement community after consultation with the County Sheriff, and the other seven shall represent the five County Council Districts following consultation with each County Councilmember, and two at-large members; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has consulted with the Sheriff to solicit recommendations for representatives on the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Executive nominates Robert Ogawa to serve as the Law Enforcement Community Representative on the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council confirms the appointment of Robert Ogawa to represent the Law Enforcement Community Representative on the Snohomish County Commission on Human Rights with a term ending July 1, 2025.
