Subject: Award of Workforce Project Funds to Cares of Washington.

Scope: This motion approves the agreement between Snohomish County and AJAC to provide youth apprenticeship job placement efforts for Sno-Isle, Snohomish, and Everett School District youth, pre-apprenticeship with the launching of a new training site for 50 youth per year with disabilities who are interested in aerospace/advanced manufacturing, and adult apprenticeship funding for enhanced employer engagement efforts to increase apprenticeship enrollment capacity across three new programs (logistics specialist, operations specialist, and aircraft mechanic).
