**Subject:** Interlocal agreement for overlay improvements.

**Scope:** The ordinance would approve an interlocal agreement for overlay improvements to 132<sup>nd</sup>/134<sup>th</sup> /Cathcart Way from Seattle Hill Road to SR9.

The Silver Lake Water and Sewer District installed sewer line upgrades, which require an overlay. It is mutually beneficial to complete a single overlay to the affected area, and the County has received federal NHS funding for the project. The County and Silver Lake Water and Sewer District have negotiated the ILA, which includes overall planning, design, and construction, as outlined in the Ordinance 23-092 attached Exhibit A.

**Duration:** The term is from execution through December 31, 2033.

**Background:** The Agreement is authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act, chapter 39.34 RCW, and allows for the County and the Silver Lake Water and Sewer District to work together efficiently and effectively to accomplish mutually beneficial projects. The two entities shall cooperate to the extent reasonably necessary for accomplishing the projects and the district shall reimburse the County for the County's actual costs incurred in performing the Design Services and Construction Services as stipulated in Exhibit A of the Ordinance.
