The board has five members and two alternates that serve three year terms and may not serve more than three consecutive full terms. The board must convene to hear appeals filed for the current year, and may do so at any time, with the Council's approval, when petitions filed exceed 25 or ten percent of the number of appeals filed in the preceding year. The Board has received approximately 1,750 appeal petitions for the 2022 assessment year and has received over 500 so far for the current 2023 assessment year. This meets the criteria for convening as proposed by Motion 23-356.
