Consideration:

Authorize the Executive to execute two Intergovernmental Agreement’s for the county and the jurisdictions to make purchases off of the others awarded contracts.

Background:

RCW 39.34.303 and SCC 3.04.220 allows the County to enter into intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreements with other public agencies. In 2013 Snohomish County began including language in its solicitations to allow other public agencies to purchase from contracts awarded by the County. The two cities in these agreements and Snohomish County each desire to make purchases, from time to time, from contracts the other has awarded as a result of a competitive process.

Council approval is required for all intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreements.

These two motions allow the County and the respective jurisdiction to utilize the other parties competitively awarded contracts as authorized by applicable laws.
