shall be effective pursuant to Sections 7 and 8.

ORDINANCE NO. 22-009
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE VACATION AND
ABANDONNET OF A PORTION OF RICHMIONID ROAD AND A
PORTION OF 208TH ST SE, SNOHOMISH COUNTY ROAD
RIGHTS-OF WAY
Section 1, Adopts ordinance recitable as findings.
Section 2, Finding that the county roads rights-of-way described
in Exhibits A and B and depicted in Exhibits A1 and B1, are
useless for county road purposes and the public will benefited by
their vacation.

Describits A and B and depicted in Exhibits A1 and B1, are useless for county road purposes and the public will benefited by their vacation.

Section 3. States that the county road rights-of-way described in Exhibits A1 and B1 are vacated upon satisfaction of the terms and condition contained in the ordinance.

Section 4. Conditioning the vacation upon the Petitioner paying the itemized costs and expenses under SCC 13.100.070 within one year of the adoption of the ordinance.

Section 5. States that the road rights-of-way petitioned to be vacated and abandoned are classified as Class C under SCC 13.100.040(7) (d) and under SCC 13.100.085, the Petitioner is required to compensate the County 50 percent of the appraised value unless such requirement is waived by the County Council under SCC 13.100.0(3). The requirement that the Petitioner pay 50 percent of the appraised value of the vacated portions of the rights-of way is waived as allowed under SCC 13.100.080(3) because the Petitioner is providing the County a new County road of greater utility to public transportation purposes.

Section 6. States that the County retains an easement in respect to the vacated land for the construction, repair and maintenance of utilities and services within the vacated portions of the rights-of way as allowed under RCW 38.87.140 and SCC 13.100.100.

Section 7. States that the county council receiving confirmation from the Department of Public Works that the Petitioner has made the required payment and if Petitioner fails to make necessary payments within one year of the adoption of this ordinance this ordinance will become void and no turther force or effect.

Section 8. States that the ordinance shall not be recorded, and the vacation shall not be effective until the new Richmond Road extension identified as "Road A" in the May 4.2021, administrative site plan approval for the Camberfield SFDU (File Number 19 113061 SPA) is constructed and accepted by the County and satabilished as a County road.
