Subject: Approving Amendment No. 1 to an Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Bothell.

Scope: Amendment No. 1 adds a one-year extension to the existing agreement (set to expire on February 20, 2026) having exhausted the two available three-year extensions. The two parties are actively negotiating a new agreement and desire to continue services during negotiations. All other terms and conditions of the underlying agreement remain the same.

Background: The County executed the original Interlocal Agreement via [Ordinance 13-003](#) on February 19, 2014 (the agreement prior to Ordinance 13-003 was executed in August 2007). Under the approved agreement, the County provides signal and street light maintenance for the City of Bothell. Additional services can be requested and approved through work orders. The county is reimbursed for services on a time and materials basis.
