Consideration

Motion 22-373 would approve the Snohomish County Board of Equalization's request to convene for the purpose of hearing appeals filed for the 2022 assessment year.

Background

The Board of Equalization reviews appeals to assessed valuation of real and personal property. The board has five members and two alternates that serve three-year terms and may not serve more than three consecutive full terms. The board must convene to hear appeals filed for the current year, and may do so at any time, with the council's approval, when petitions filed exceed 25 or ten percent of the number of appeals filed in the preceding year. The Board has received over 1500 appeal petitions for the 2022 assessment year, which meets the criteria for convening.

Motion 22-373 would convene the Board of Equalization to begin hearing appeals.
