Subject: Approval of the Right-of-Way Plan for Larson Road Bridge 101 Seismic Retrofit Project

Scope: While work is conducted on the Larson Road Bridge 101 Seismic Retrofit (Council District 1), the County has need for temporary easements on five parcels beginning in 2026.

The five parcels represent 34,221 in square feet for a total acquisition subtotal of \$106,000 in costs associated with acquisition, title & escrow costs, waiver valuation, labor, misc. fees, and statutory evaluation allowance.

Land disturbing notices were sent out on December 20, 2025.

Duration: Though the duration of the project – estimated completion in 2028.

Fiscal Impact: Current Year Multi-Year N/A

Note – the federal funding requires a 13.5% match after September 2026.

Larson Bridge 101 – Seismic Retrofit

This 304-foot-long three span bridge with seismically deficient elements was built in 1962 prior to current seismic design standards. The bridge carries Larson Road over the South Slough of the Stillaguamish River in Silvana. Federal seismic retrofit funds became available in 2024 and construction is planned in 2028.

Requested Action: Move this motion to GLS on January 28th for Council to consider taking action.
