## Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-488 which would approve and authorize Amendment No. 3 for legal services.

## Background

A lawsuit, filed on October 28, 2020, in King County Superior Court named Snohomish County and Snohomish County employees necessitating a procurement for the legal services of an outside firm. The Rules of Professional Conduct preclude the Civil Division from representing the County, former employees, and volunteers acting on behalf of Snohomish County.
Independent outside counsel was selected and the original contract for special services with Friemund Tardif, PLLC on August 25, 2020 for an amount of up to $\$ 50,000$. Amendment No. 1 added an attorney to the agreement. Amendment No. 2 was executed on February 23, 2022 by Motion 22-036 ${ }^{1}$ and increased the not-to-exceed amount to $\$ 100,000$. Continued representation is needed in this matter.

## Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-483 approves Amendment No 3. with Simmons Sweeney Friemund Tardif PLLC for continued outside counsel in this matter.

Duration: Unknown - dependent upon resolution
Fiscal Implications: $\$ 50,000$ for a total not-to-exceed amount of $\$ 250,000$
