The commission, consisting of twenty-five members, advises the County Executive and Department of Human Services on issues of health, safety, and social services for infants, young children, and youth in Snohomish County. The commission can: Conduct hearings to determine and provide community forums related to health, mental health, safety, and social services needs and priorities for people up to age 18 years old, Provide reports and advise Snohomish County on priorities, objectives, and tasks

human services, youth, elected officials, and minorities. The County Council may name an ex officio member to the commission.

Terms for people under the age of 18 are one year and for people 18 and over are four years. People may serve up to three consecutive terms. After serving three consecutive terms, a person may serve additional terms after two years' absence from the commission.
