Consideration:

Approve an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Lake Stevens and Snohomish County for surveying and planning of a 1.3 mile trail connection.

Background:

Annually, the County Council adopts a Capital Improvement Program budget that includes City/Council Partnership Projects. During the 2021 budget process \$750,000 was set aside in Ordinance 20-071 for these projects (projects added via Amendment #1). While funding was appropriated for each of these projects in the budget, ILA's with each jurisdiction are required in order to disburse the funds.
