PROPOSED MOTION NO. 21-296
REAPPOINTING KERI MOORE TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY
PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Planning Commission is established and administered pursuant to chapter 2.08 SCC; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Moore's first full term, representing County Council District 1, expired on July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, appointments to fill vacant planning commission positions are made pursuant to Snohomish County Charter section 2.20 and SCC 2.08.080; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 states that vacancies shall be filled by the Council with nominees from the County Council and/or Executive; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080(2) sets out the procedure by which the County council will hold a public hearing on nominations and make affirmative findings on the following:

1. Is the nominee a full-time resident of Snohomish County?
2. Is the nominee not a Snohomish County employee except while serving as a temporary appointee?
3. Does the nominee have sufficient time to attend all scheduled commission meetings?

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 also states that it is desirable that the nominee has knowledge of a) land use theories, b) growth management and agricultural preservation studies, c) have a minimum potential for conflict of interest, d) have a demonstrated interest in the welfare of Snohomish County, and e) add balance to county-wide representation on the commission; and

WHEREAS, SCC 2.03.060 requires a satisfactory attendance record for reappointments, as well as a demonstration of continuing benefits of retaining the commission member; and

WHEREAS, Keri Moore was appointed to the Snohomish County Planning Commission, representing the at-large position, to serve a partial term expiring July 1, 2021, via motion 19-134 on May 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Keri Moore has served effectively on the Planning Commission, with a satisfactory attendance record, and her reappointment would provide continuing benefits; and

WHEREAS, under Snohomish County Charter section 2.20 and SCC 2.08.080, County Executive Dave Somers has nominated Ken Moore for reappointment to the at-large position for a first full term, to expire four years from the effective date of this motion; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on _____, 2021, to consider the nomination.

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council finds that the nominee meets the criteria set out in SCC 2.08.080 and hereby appoints Keri Moore to the Snohomish County Planning Commission to serve first full term, which expires on _____.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed motion.
