## **Consideration:**

Authorize the Executive to execute Amendment #7 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with J.A. Brennan and Associates.

## **Background**

In 2016, Snohomish County put forth a Request for Qualifications, seeking consultant services for park design, engineering, and permit support to update a conceptual plan developed for the day-use portion of Kayak Point Park and to also develop a Preferred Plan for the undeveloped portion of the park. J.A. Brennan Associates, PLLC was selected through a competitive review process as the best qualified firm to complete the identified work. The original agreement for \$554,999 was approved by Motion 16-425<sup>1</sup> on October 11, 2016.

Since then, six amendments have been made to the original contract:

Due to an increase in construction value for the project and extension of the project timeline from Phase 1 construction starting in 2021 to starting in 2023 or 2024, an amendment to the contract is necessary for additional construction, permitting and design support.

## **Current Proposal**

Scope: Amendment No. 7 amends the scope of work to provide additional environmental permit support; design and pier improvements, permitting updates, and building structural updates; administration/project management/coordination; interpretive signage design; bid support for Phase 1; enhanced stormwater treatment feasibility concept; construction administrative support for Phase 1; and construction acoustic monitoring for Phase 1.
