Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-306 which would approve and authorize an agreement between the county and the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) to implement the Long-Term Care program administration.

Background

The Snohomish County Long Term Care and Aging (LTCA) Area Plan provides community leadership on issues related to aging. [LTCA](#) plans, coordinates and advocates for the development and delivery of a range of services helping older adults meet their needs and maximize their potential; additionally, LTCA develops a comprehensive and coordinated system of services for older adults as the designated [Area Agency on Aging](#).

This grant, with the Washington State Department of Health and Social Services, Aging and Long Term Support Administration (ALTSA) was included in the 2022 Human Services Grant Work plan¹ in an amount of \$11,917,542; the final award is greater than \$50,000 over the anticipated amount and therefore requires council consideration pursuant to [SCC 4.26.025](#).

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-306 approves the grant agreement between the county and the Washington State Department of Health and Social Services, Aging and Long Term Support Administration. As a result of this award, the County will coordinate services to include: Case Management services for Medicaid financed home care and Chore service; Home Care Contract Management; Senior Information and Assistance; Ethnic Meal Transportation; Stabilized Housing; Non-Core Case Management; Adult Day Health; State Family Caregiver Support; Kinship Caregiver Support Program; Senior Drug Education; Home Delivered Meals Expansion; and Senior Farmer's Market.

Duration: July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023

Fiscal Implications: \$14,989,966. Required match for funding received from TXIX AAA: \$168,232 will be met with State SCSA Grant Funds and \$195,998 will be met with general funds.
