## ACTION ITEMS

1. Motion 22-367, authorizing the County Executive to sign a Professional Services Contract for Forensic Pathology with Nicole Croom [2022-0871](#)

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She explained that this contract increases the available contract dollars to \$50,000.00. The term of the contract remains through December 31, 2022, and all other terms and conditions remain the same.

2. Motion 22-380, authorizing the County Executive to sign a Professional Services Contract for Forensic Pathology with Dr. Lindsey Harle [2022-0887](#)

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She explained that this amendment increases the not to exceed amount to \$50,000.00. The term of the contract is through February 28, 2023, and all other terms and conditions remain the same.

3. Motion 22-374, approving the 2022-2023 Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the Stanwood Camano School District relating to School Resource Officer Services [2022-0882](#)

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She stated the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office and Stanwood High School both wish to continue their agreement to provide School Resource Officers to Stanwood High School, beginning September 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 for an amount of \$126,636.00.

4. Motion 22-375, approving the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Gold Bar relating to Law Enforcement Services [2022-0883](#)

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She stated this agreement requires Snohomish County to provide one sergeant and four deputies to provide patrol services and other associated services to the City of Gold Bar. The City will provide office space and supplies while also maintaining the agreement for use of the emergency radio system. She stated the agreement is for the amount of \$417,106.00 and is effective January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

**ACTION:** Move to Consent Agenda, General Legislative Session September 21st for consideration.

5. Motion 22-381, approve and authorize the County Executive to execute the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts Reimbursement Agreement [2022-0877](#)

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She explained that District Court was awarded \$292,885.00 from the Administrative Office of the Courts. She explained that the funds would aid in the improvements of the Courts audio and visual equipment, along with other services. The term of the agreement is July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Ms. Beazizo stated there is a net zero impact to the General Fund as no match is required.
