Cocoon House provides navigation and support services to assist participants to identify natural supports, community resources, and secure, safe, and viable housing options.
Cocoon House / Catholic Community Services: YHDP Joint TH-RRH	\$788,080	Three (3) leased units of transitional housing (TH) in Everett and seventeen (17) scattered-site units of RRH throughout Snohomish County for homeless young adults ages 18 to 24. Cocoon House and Catholic Community Services provide transitional housing, tenant-based rental assistance, case management and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.

Domestic Violence Services: Rapid Rehousing DVS	\$167,887	Six (6) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families. Domestic Violence Services of Snohomish County (DVSSC) provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Domestic Violence Services: Rapid Rehousing Non-CoC Expansion	\$292,473	Ten (10) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families. DVSSC provides tenant-based rental assistance, case management, and other supportive services to assist participants in achieving housing stability.
Domestic Violence Services: Joint TH-RRH	259,971	Two (2) leased units of transitional housing and six (6) scattered-site units of RRH at confidential locations for survivors of domestic violence and their families.
