Subject: Board Reappointments – Airport Commission

Scope: Motion 24-060 (ECAF 24-0112) would reappoint Mathew Army to a 2nd term
Motion 24-061 (ECAF 24-0115) would reappoint Dennis Brawford to a 3rd term
Motion 24-062 (ECAF 24-0116) would reappoint Glen Bachman to a 3rd Term
Motion 24-063 (ECAF 24-0117) would reappoint Mark Darrow to a 3rd Term
Motion 24-064 (ECAF 24-0118) would reappoint Mathew Faletti to a 3rd Term
Motion 24-065 (ECAF 24-0119) would reappoint Joseph Nguyen to a 3rd Term

Background:

The Board: The current form of the Airport Commission began in 2017 with passage of Ordinance 17-003.¹ [Snohomish County Code 15.04.020](#) provides for the establishment and membership. There are 13 members, consisting of one from each council district (five total), three from the airport tenant community, three from the business community, and two from the county at large. The Airport Commission advises the County Executive as provided in [SCC 15.04.030](#). Commissioners serve terms of up to four years and shall not serve more than three consecutive terms on the commission ([SCC 2.03.050](#)). Existing commissioners may continue to serve until appointment of a successor ([SCC 2.03.030\(2\)](#)). The original thirteen commissioners appointed by [Motion 18-029](#) had staggered two- and four-year terms.

The nominees: There are six current nominees for reappointment. Mathew Army represents Council District #4. His original appointment to complete a vacant partial first term was by Motion 22-268.

The other five reappointments began their service with first terms of two years under Motion 18-029. These five commissioners were then all reappointed to second terms of four years by [Motion 20-006](#). Dennis Brawford represents at-large interests. Glen Bachman represents the business community. Mark Darrow represent airport tenants. Mathew Faletti represents the business community. Joseph Nguyen represents Council District 2.

All nominees are well qualified to serve or to continue serving. The County Executive recommends approval of all six reappointments.

Request: Move Motions 24-060 to 24-065 to General Legislative Session on February 7, 2024, for consideration.
