

Background: The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement
(ILA) between Snohomish County, the City of Evereit and
Marshland Flood Control District (the District), Snohomish County
has had agreements with the District since 1988 to compensate
them for the increased costs associated with the incremental effect
of development on stormwater runoff. Higher costs result from
runoff handling (pumpling), sediment handling, and related
maintenance, operation, and capital costs. The County, the City
and the District negostated an agreement to share the costs due to
upland runoff with a new five-year ILA. The County estimates
payments under this agreement to average about \$55,000 per
year, but exact totals each year will depend on cost rolling
averages, CPI, Marshland Capital Fund contribution and true-upof PUD costs. The new ILA will become effective upon execution
through December 31, 2029.
At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to
the proposed ordinance.


