PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 24-037

GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING  
LIMITED USE OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN PORTIONS  
OF UNINCORPORATED SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO  
SAM LAKE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

Sam Lake Improvement Association, a non-profit corporation, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair water distribution systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

<u>Township</u>	<u>Range</u>	<u>Sections</u>
Twp. 30N	Rge. 4E	Sects. 1

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 24-037 would grant said franchise to Sam Lake Improvement Association, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by Sam Lake Improvement Association, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.



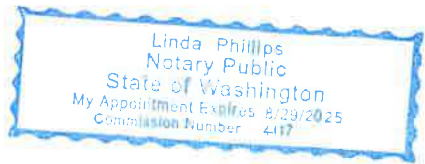
