## PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 086

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED AND ESTABLISHING A NEW PORTION OF 49<sup>th</sup> Dr SE

<u>Summary:</u> The proposed Ordinance approves the acceptance of a Statutory Warranty Deed for right-of-way and establish 49<sup>th</sup> Dr SE as a new public road. Northshore School District # 417 is constructing the new 49<sup>th</sup> Dr SE as a condition of approval for the Maltby Elementary and Middle School site plan (PDS File No. 17 110535 CUP). A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

Section 1. Adopts findings of fact.

Section 2. Finds that Northshore School District # 417 intends to deed property described in Section 3 for the use of the public in perpetuity by Statutory Warranty Deed.

Section 3. Provides the full legal description of the right-of-way and establishes 49<sup>th</sup> Dr SE as County road right-of-way subject to the conditions in Section 7.

Section 4. Requires Northshore School District # 417 to construct the road to County design standards at its own expense.

Section 5. Finds that 49<sup>th</sup> Dr SE is a public necessity, is practicable, and the public will be benefited by its establishment.

Section 6. Authorizes the County Executive to accept the deed on behalf of the County.

Section 7. Provides conditions before establishment becomes effective.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
