APPOINTING COMMISSIONER TO REPRESENT ORGANIZED LABOR ON THE CITIZENS' COMMISSION ON SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials is made up of ten members and was created to study the relationship of salaries to the duties of all elected officials and to fix the salary for each position; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is charged with filing a schedule of salaries for elected officials with the Council and Auditor every two years, beginning no later than May 1, 2008, and no later than May 1 every two years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, six of the members are selected by lot by the County Auditor: one from each Council district and one at-large member who may reside anywhere within the County; and

WHEREAS, the remaining four appointments are nominated by the County Executive. Of these four members, one each will be selected from the business sector, professional personnel management, the legal profession, and organized labor; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte Murry has expressed interest in a second-term appointment to serve on the Commission to represent organized labor; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte Murry was an exemplary contributor to the Commission in 2022 who is a valued colleague to staff, including leadership and represented employees throughout the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council hereby confirms the appointment of Charlotte Murry to the Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials to serve a second and final two-year term ending December 31, 2025.
