Under RCW 29A.16.040, the Snohomish County Auditor may adjust precinct boundaries at any time unless it is within 14 days of the first day candidates can begin to file for the primary election.

Snohomish County Code allows the Snohomish County Auditor to temporarily adjust precinct boundaries under the provisions of RCW 29A.16.040 and RCW 29A.161.050. An ordinance submitted to the Council to adjust voting precinct boundaries must be adopted
