MOTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AMENDMENT NO. 1  
FOR NALOXONE DISTRIBUTION BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND  
CITY OF LYNNWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Snohomish Health District was integrated into Snohomish County effective December 31, 2022, and now operates as the Snohomish County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, prior to its integration into Snohomish County, the Snohomish Health District entered into an agreement with the City of Lynnwood Police Department, for the distribution and acceptance of naloxone; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish Health District assigned its interest in the Original Agreement to Snohomish County effective December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Health Department recognizes the public health, safety, and welfare benefits of promoting wider availability of naloxone within Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Health Department wishes to continue our partnership with the City of Lynnwood Police Department and continue the distribution and acceptance of naloxone with first responders; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood Police Department have a desire to assist vulnerable communities in need of naloxone; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for naloxone, Snohomish County Health Department will receive data regarding opioid overdoses occurring within Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County, acting through the Health Department, have executed numerous naloxone distribution agreements, and this agreement does not represent a new program;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the County Council hereby authorizes the Executive to sign an amendment with City of Lynnwood Police Department for the distribution and acceptance of naloxone.
