### 2024 Budget Questions

1. Please provide a breakdown by: Permanent FTE (total FTE, how many are new in 2023, requested in 2024) and Temporary/Project (total FTE, how many are new in 2023, requested in 2024).

- o 134 Permanent FTEs in 2023
- 138 Permanent FTEs requested in 2024 (4 new)
- Projection positions: None in 2023 and 2024
- Temporary staff: 0 FTEs but there is a budget for temps (# varies)

2. Of those positions, how many are filled, actively recruiting, or vacant? What unfunded positions from the 2023 budget are you requesting to fund/fill in 2024?

- o 123 positions are filled
- 7 vacant positions actively recruiting
- 4 vacant positions pending recruitment
- No unfunded positions from 2023 requested to be filled



### 2024 Budget Questions

#### 3. What are your experiences with a hybrid/remote working environment?

- Approximately 75% of PDS employees are working remotely full time. 15% are hybrid and another 10% work full time in the office.
- Remote work has been a success. Many permit review staff find they are more productive working at home due the reduction of distractions in the office.
- PDS's permit process is 100% electronic, so permit processing is very suitable for remote work.
- Remote work, whether full time or hybrid, is offered to employees whose job is suitable for such. Employees who are needed to support on-site functions and in-person customer service come into the office
- As a result of remote work, PDS is reducing its office footprint by 1/3.
