7 ORDINANCE NO. 25-019

9 DISSOLVING THE LOCHSLOY PILCHUCK FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT  
10 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 36.96 RCW

12 WHEREAS, the Lochsloy Pilchuck Flood Control District (hereinafter District), is  
13 a special purpose district governed by the laws of the state of Washington and subject  
14 to dissolution in accordance with Chapter 36.96 RCW et seq.; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council held a public hearing on  
17 \_\_\_\_\_ to consider evidence and testimony relating to the proposed  
18 dissolution of the District;

19  
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

21  
22 Section 1. The County Council adopts the following findings in support of this  
23 ordinance:

- 24 A. The foregoing recitals are adopted as findings as if set forth in full herein.  
25 B. The District has not held commissioner elections within the preceding  
26 consecutive seven-year period.  
27 C. The District has not carried out any of the special purposes or functions for  
28 which it was formed within the preceding consecutive five-year period.  
29 D. The District has never imposed assessments on properties within the District.  
30 E. The district has no assets or liabilities.  
31 F. Following the formation of the district, commissioners declined to proceed  
32 with the proposed improvements and levying of assessments due to:  
33 a. Estimated costs exceeding the district residents' ability to support the  
34 necessary level of assessment.  
35 b. The district's inability to obtain necessary permits for the proposed  
36 improvements.

37  
38 Section 2. The County Council makes the following conclusions:

- 39 A. The District is inactive pursuant to RCW 36.96.010.  
40 B. It is in the public interest to dissolve the district based on the findings set forth  
41 in Section 1 above.
