Background: The Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) arrest diversion program is a collaborative community safety effort that offers law enforcement a credible alternative to booking people into jail for criminal activity that stems from unmet behavioral health needs or poverty.¹

The Prosecuting Attorney's office is the lead agency for Snohomish County's LEAD program. As a complementary program, the PA's office would like to establish a Recovery Navigator Program (RNP) (<u>RCW 71.24.115</u>) on behalf of the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization (NSBH-ASO²). This program provides community-based outreach, intake, assessment and connection to services for youth and adults with substance use disorder (SUD), including individuals with co-occurring SUD's and mental health conditions.

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The current contract³ is for a grant from the NSBH-ASO to the County in the amount of \$645,000 through June 30, 2024. The grant dollars will be passed through to the Public Defender's Association and the Recovery Navigator Coordinator for operation of the program. Amendments to these agreements are anticipated. Standards for the RNC are published by the Health Care Authority.⁴

The NSBH-ASO notified north sound counties of additional funding available. Snohomish County put in for additional funds and was awarded an additional \$93,500 for the LEAD, Recovery Navigator Program.
