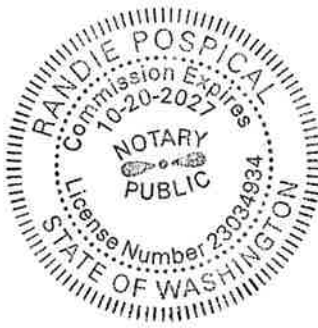

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 26-012
APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY
PUBLIC FACILITIES DISTRICT CHARTER

Summary: The Ordinance amends the Snohomish County Public Facilities District (PFD) Charter for the following purposes: to (i) adopt a later deadline for the PFD Board of Director's adoption of the annual budget, (ii) expand the ability of Board Members to participate in Board Meetings remotely, (iii) resolve conflicts between the Bylaws and Charter on the process for amending the Bylaws and Charter, (iv) update the list of characteristics protected by law, and (v) make other minor edits, as set forth in the Amended and Restated Charter.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
