MOTION NO. 25-519

APPROVING A BUDGET TRANSFER OR REALLOCATION
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services requested that the County Council approve a budget transfer or reallocation in the amount of \$375,000 from Pending Grant Expenditure and Revenue line item(s) in Program 777 to Program 212 Energy Conservation Education to provide the appropriation necessary to operate the Energy Assistance Program at planned levels for the 2025-2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, having considered the request at a public meeting, the County Council finds that a budget transfer or reallocation should be approved as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council takes the following actions pursuant to SCC 4.26.130:

1. The County Council approves a budget transfer or reallocation as set out below:


