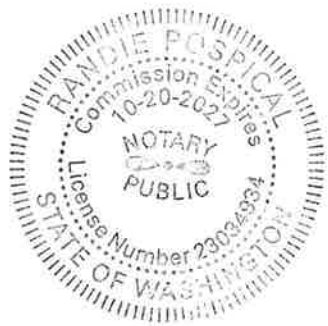

PROVIDE EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR THE OFFICE OF

WASHINGTON STATE OFFICE OF PUBLIC DEFENSE  
Summary: The ordinance approves a supplemental appropriation  
in the Office of Public Defense (OPD) 2025-2026 budget in the  
amount of \$447,697.02. OPD received more funding than  
anticipated from the State Indigent Defense Improvement Funds.  
The supplemental appropriation is for the additional amount of  
authority needed to match the amount of grant funds received.
