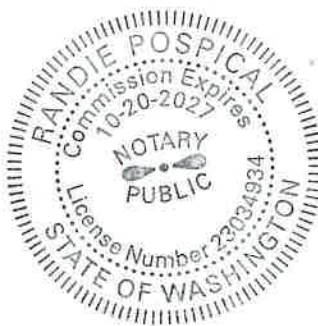

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-035

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE FRANCHISE GRANTED BY
ORDINANCE NO. 22-063 AUTHORIZING LIMITED USE OF THE
PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY,
WASHINGTON TO INTERMOUNTAIN INFRASTRUCTURE
GROUP, LLC

Intermountain Infrastructure Group, LLC, a Delaware limited liability corporation (the "Grantee"), was issued a telecommunications franchise agreement by Ordinance No. 22-063, which became effective February 14, 2023, for a period not to exceed twenty years.

Ordinance No. 22-063 allows the Grantee a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair of telecommunications facilities in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

Twp. 27N	Rge. 7E	Sects. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6

Twp. 28N	Rge. 7E	Sects. 32, 33, 34, 35 & 36

The Grantee has since requested the geographical limits of its franchise agreement be expanded to include all public rights-of-way within unincorporated Snohomish County.

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 25-035 would amend Grantee's telecommunications franchise granted by Ordinance 22-063 to expand the franchise area and also include the County's standard franchise compensation reservation language.

If approved, the franchise amendment would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by the Grantee, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise remains twenty (20) years from the effective date of the franchise granted by Ordinance No. 22-063.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.

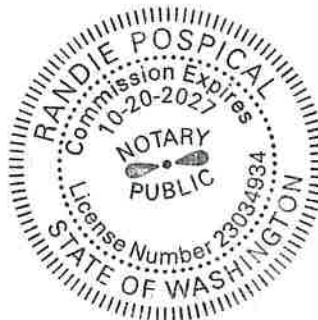
