### BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

A competitive Request for Proposals – Software (RFP-C) was issued for ShareGate licenses. The Snohomish County Department of Information Technology currently employs ShareGate Migrate Pro, which previously was competed under QT-005-19BC, in accordance with SCC 3.04.160. The aggregate cost of software licenses would have exceeded \$50,000.00 beginning in 2026, requiring a new competition.

This RFP-C establishes a new master agreement for subscriptions of ShareGate Migrate Pro. The initial award term will be for five (5) years, ending January 31, 2030, with the option to extend for additional five-year terms for the life of the product's use by the County. Total expenditure for the initial five-year term is anticipated to be approximately \$55,000.00.

In accordance with RFP-25-0622JM-C, proposals were ranked using the following evaluation criteria:

- Price/cost
- Adherence to RFP requirements


