CALL TO ORDER

Council Chair Dunn called the public hearing to order at 10:30 a.m.

1. Amended Ordinance 22-008, amending Snohomish County Code section 3A.06.055 relating to employee military service

Council Chair Dunn opened the hearing and the clerk read the ordinance title into the record.

Jim Martin, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report and an overview of the proposed Substitute Ordinance. He also pointed out a scrivener's error on page 1, line 31, which should read "United States".

Council Chair Dunn opened the hearing for public testimony and provided instructions for those wishing to provide public comment for both in-person and remotely via Zoom. There being no persons present wishing to provide public testimony, she closed the testimony portion of the hearing calling for a motion or discussion of the Council.

Councilmember Nehring thanked staff for working on the ordinance and substitute ordinance. He also thanked Joe Davis, a County employee and member of the military, for his contributions in drafting the legislation. He noted that Mr. Davis planned to testify at the hearing, however, he is currently serving overseas and has provided written testimony.

Council Chair Dunn spoke in support of the ordinance and also thanked Councilmember Nehring and staff for their work in drafting the legislation.

ACTION: Council Vice-Chair Mead made a motion to approve proposed Substitute Ordinance 22-008, and direct the Clerk to correct the scrivener's error as noted by Council staff. Councilmember Wright seconded the motion. The clerk called the roll and the motion to approve Ordinance 22-008, as amended, carried unanimously.
