Subject: Award of Workforce Project Funds to Edmonds College.

Scope: This motion approves the agreement between Snohomish County and Edmonds College for the Expanding Career Connected Learning project. This project expands Edmond’s College’s Construction pre-Apprenticeship Program (CAP). This program prepares individuals for apprenticeships and careers in the construction trades. Funds will be used to fund access for students to the CAP program at no cost to the students; enhancements to the CAP program to better serve Snohomish County’s linguistically and culturally diverse population; partnerships with community-based organizations to provide program outreach materials and recruitment in languages other than English; and partnerships with community-based organizations to provide individualized translation services and guidance for students enrolled in the linguistically and culturally diverse cohorts.
