Approved as to Form: □Yes ⊠No □N/A	Background: Since 1986 Snohomish County has partnered with the U.S. Department of the Interior, U.S. Geological Survey to jointly fund the operation and maintenance of stream and river gages located along the Snohomish, Skykomish and Stillaguamish rivers. Additional stream and river gages have been installed along the North Fork Stillaguamish River near SR 530 Slide to monitor the site. The monitoring of these river basins provides information related to salmon habitat restoration design, flood mitigation, other water resource issues including but not limited to real-time river levels during storms to aid in evacuation planning and response.				

Pursuant to the authority granted in 43 U.S.C. 36C, 43 U.S.C 50, and 43 U.S.C 50b the USGS and Snohomish County agree to maintain in cooperation operation and maintenance of the cooperative stream gaging program, as outlined in the fixed cost agreement (Form 9-1366), a total of nine USGS Stations.
