Consideration:

The proposed motion would authorize the County Executive to sign Amendment 5 to the Agreement with Vertiv Corporations, (f/k/a Vertiv Service, Inc. f/k/a Emerson Network Power, Liebert Services Inc.), under SCC 3.04.140.

Background:

In 2011, the County entered into a Single Source Contract SS-002-12 agreement with Emerson Network Power, Liebert Services, Inc. to provide Uninterrupted Power Systems (UPS) for data centers located at the County Campus, Jail, Records Facility, Department of Emergency Management and the Denny Juvenile Justice Center. The UPS are needed to provide a dependable power supply for critical equipment should primary power be lost temporarily and provides protection against power surges. The original term of the agreement was for three years with the option to extend for one or more additional years upon mutual agreement.

Amendment #1 in 2013 added the DEM building, Amendment #2 in 2018 added DJJC, and Amendment #3 extended the term to 2019. Amendment #4 was negotiated in 2019 and extended the term through November 30, 2022, for an agreed to amount not to exceed \$156,105 for maintenance and on-call support.

Current Proposal:

Scope: The proposed Amendment 5 would extend the Agreement for the term an additional seven (7) months to cover maintenance and on-call emergency services.

Duration: Amendment 5 is from November 22, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

Fiscal Implications: The total agreed to amount of Amendment 5 shall not exceed \$38,726.

2023 Budget: Funds are available in the 2022-2023 Facilities Maintenance budget.

Future Budget Impacts: Funding for maintenance and support was included in the approved 2023.
