## **Consideration**

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-383 which would approve and authorize an agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Community Development for the Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME).

## **Background**

The 2022 Human Services Grant Work plan<sup>1</sup> included a HOME grant and was approved by Motion 21-362; the Grant Work Plan anticipated receipt of a grant in the amount of \$2,026,370 to support affordable housing, public facilities, infrastructure improvements, and services for primarily low and moderate income persons and neighborhoods.

Motion 22-162<sup>2</sup> approved the 2022 Annual Action Plan which included the 2022 HOME funds. The grant received and anticipated in the Funding Approval Agreement is greater than \$50,000 over the anticipated amount and therefore requires council consideration pursuant to <u>SCC 4.26.025</u>.

## **Current Proposal**

*Scope:* Motion 22-383 requests council grant the County Executive the authority to execute the HOME agreement M22-DC530201 and any related amendments.

The HOME grant will be combined with other funding sources to enact the approved 2022 Annual Action Plan (total amount of funds anticipated in the plan is \$6,009,974).

*Duration:* July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 *Fiscal Implications:* \$2,232,921 in grant funds
