Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-220 which would approve and authorize the Superior Court to hire two law clerks.

Background

On November 9, 2021, the Council adopted the 2022 Budget by Ordinance 21-093¹. The adopted budget included two (2) law clerks (NEW3602R and NEW9944R) supporting the two (2) additional Superior Court Judges. Each law clerk position is currently funded for three (3) months.

The Superior Court would like to hire the law clerks sooner than indicated in the 2022 budget, funded with salary savings.

Scope: Motion 22-220 requests the council authorize the recruitment and hiring of the two (2) law clerks.
