**RESOLUTION NO. 24-017**

**RECOGNIZING INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS (IAM)  
DISTRICT 751 FOR 12 YEARS OF SERVICE AS  
ADOPT-A-ROAD VOLUNTEERS IN SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

*WHEREAS, Snohomish County launched a local road adoption program in 2008 as a partnership between volunteer groups and the County to decrease roadside litter, enhance the quality of the environment, and build civic pride in a litter-free Snohomish County; and*

*WHEREAS, Snohomish County now has 50 adoptable segments along its network of 1,600 miles of unincorporated county roads; and*

*WHEREAS, currently 33 groups comprised of individuals, businesses, non-profit, and faith-based organizations are committed to cleaning 39 adopted road segments regularly over a two-year period to help keep communities free of litter; and*


*WHEREAS, Adopt-A-Road is part of a targeted approach by the county to keep our roads litter-free, which involves the hard work and dedication of volunteers as well as full-time and seasonal county employees; and*


*WHEREAS, Adopt-A-Road groups conduct at least two cleanups throughout the year and collect more than 100 bags of garbage from unincorporated County roadsides; and*

*WHEREAS, the members of the International Association of Machinists (IAM) District 751 Volunteer Program have committed to keeping their adopted section on 4th Ave W from 128<sup>th</sup> St SW to 105<sup>th</sup> St SW, in the south Everett area, the second Saturday seven months out of the year, clean since 2012;*


