### **Consideration:**

The proposal motion would authorize the County Executive to sign Agreement GCG 3615 with the Washington State Department of Transportation for bridge inspection services, per SCC 3.04.140(1)<sup>1</sup>.

### **Background:**

National Bridge Inspection Standards require most bridges to be routinely inspected every 24 months. Snohomish County takes care of over 200 bridges and 1,650 miles of roadway. Some of the County's bridges require special equipment and/or expertise to inspect. A similar agreement has been in place between Snohomish County and WSDOT since 2012 (Ordinance 12-024)<sup>2</sup> for this vital bridge inspection service.

### **Current Proposal:**

*Scope:* The proposed Motion would approve and authorize the execution of Agreement GCB 3615 for bridge inspection with WSDOT to provide bridge inspection services as negotiated and outlined in the proposed schedule of services as part of the agreement.

*Duration:* The term of this Agreement shall begin upon the date of execution and shall remain in effect for ten (10) years (01/31/2032). The agreement may be terminated by either party with 30-days written notice.

*Fiscal Implications:* Funding for services provided through this Agreement are included in the Professional Services budget of the Road Fund for the Department of Public Works, with an estimated cost of \$380,461.04 over the term of the agreement. WSDOT will bill based on Actual Cost at the time of service.
