Subject: Amendment 14 with Puget Sound Energy for the Low Income Weatherization Program

Scope: The Puget Sound Energy Low Income Weatherization (LIW) Grant provides funding for low-income weatherization services of gas heated units. Amendment 14 includes an additional \$200,000 in funding for space and water heater electrification funds.

This grant is included in the 2025 Department of Conservation & Natural Resources Grant Work Plan in the amount of \$485,000. This amendment increases the grant total by more than \$100,000 and requires Council approval pursuant to SCC 4.26.025. The total combined amended grant funding is \$670,338.19.
